You have been dropped from the roll according to the provisions of Sec. 1506 of ARTICLE XV, of the Grand Lodge By-laws, which read as follows:

“Any member refusing or neglecting to pay dues for a period of two years and whose dues have not been paid or remitted shall automatically be dropped from the roll without further action of the Lodge. He shall be notified by the Secretary, by registered mail to his last know address of such action, and advised of the amount of his delinquent dues and the procedure for reinstatement.

The standing of a member dropped from the roll shall be that of a non-affiliate without a demit.”

We regret very much to see you dropped and urge that you become reinstated as provided in Sec. 1507 of ART XV, which reads as follows:

1. Within one year from the date when he was dropped from the roll, a Mason shall be reinstated by the payment or remission of all dues accrued, including those accrued since he was dropped.
2. After the lapse of more than one year since he was dropped, a Mason may be reinstated by payment, or remission, of all dues accrued at the time he was dropped, and petitioning for reinstatement.”

We hope that you will take advantage of paragraph 1 of the above section.
